



In accordance with the provisions of the Law on Associations, Articles number 78 and number 12 (Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia, number 51/09) and Article number 9 of the current Statute, the assembly of the association AGENDA, Centre for Family Support, held on February 11, 2011, in Belgrade, has adopted the following:

STATUTE

of the Association AGENDA, Centre for Family Support

Article 1

Association “AGENDA, Centre for Family Support”, abbreviated AGENDA (hereinafter Association) is voluntary, non-governmental and non profit organization that gathers individuals of different occupations from the Republic of Serbia to provide expert, psycho-social, educational, material and other kinds of support to family and its members, affirmation of civil society values and development of ecological awareness in our society.

Article 2

The aims of the Association are:

1. Affirmation of the civil society values and development of democracy;
2. Strengthening the family as a basic social unit, through the different forms of help to the family as well as to their members to help to overcome the crises;
3. Providing support to children of all age, from preschool children to adolescents, through psychological, social and informative workshops, as well as through providing different kinds of possibilities for their creative expression, self-affirmation and developing their personalities;
4. Empowerment of some categories of population which are in unequal position compared to the average population, because of their life circumstances or social prejudices;
5. Developing environmental awareness and affirmation of healthy life styles;
6. Affirmation of the gender equality;
7. Developing the multicultural awareness and strengthen fellowship between different ethnic groups.

Article 3

To achieve its goals, Association specially emphasizes the following activities:

Description of tasks:

1. Establishment of creative workshops and clubs for children and young people in every milieu where children are deprived of this type of social affirmation;
2. Establishment of counseling services to support family, through expert assistance for solving all problems related to parenthood and partnership;
3. Organizing cultural and artistic projects in social culturally neglected areas (rural areas, impoverished cities, Roma settlements);
4. Educational support to children, young people and adults;



5. Organizing economic activities with the aim of more efficient implementation of program activities;
6. Empowerment of economically disadvantaged families, as well as single parents through various projects that facilitate additional or permanent employment;
7. Organization of exhibitions, concerts, performances, summer camps promoting children's creativity and multicultural richness of some social areas;
8. Organizing (independently or in a cooperation with other organizations) professional gatherings, conferences, seminars and other forms of improvement in relevant areas;
9. Cooperation with interested experts and associations in the county and abroad;
10. Collecting, processing and publication of professional and scientific literature from relevant areas, as well as popularization of democratic principals, tolerance and quality cohabitation through publishing of appropriate promotional material and adequate literature;
11. Publishing original literary works, comics and other forms of creative expression of children of all age, with special emphasize on adolescents.

Article 4

The name of the association is "AGENDA, Centar za podršku porodici". Short name of the Association is "AGENDA".

The name of the Association in English is "AGENDA, Centre for Family Support", short name "AGENDA".

Headquarters of the association is in Belgrade, Solunskih boraca 4/32.

Association realizes its activities in the territory of the Republic of Serbia, in cooperation with kindred domestic and international organizations, associations and other legal organizations and individuals in the country and abroad.

Article 5

Any person who accepts the goals of the Association and their Statute can be a member of the Association, based on recommendation of one current member.

The members of the association are persons that have established the Association, as well as any person who later becomes a member, namely, joins the Association after its establishment.

A minor aged 14 can become a member of the Association if he/she submits a verified statement by his/her legal representative on granting the consent.

For persons below the age of 14 referred to in paragraph 1 of this article, the application is submitted by his/her legal representative.

Article 6

The assembly decides on the admission to membership and informs the applicant without delay.

A member can resign from membership by giving a written statement of resignation. There is no need of consent of the legal representative for withdrawal from the Association.

Persons who are not citizens of Serbia could be members of the Association as well.

A membership card will be issued to the member of the Association, and he/she is obligated to pay the membership fee.

The assembly decides on termination of membership.

The member has to be given a chance to declare him/herself regarding the reasons for which a motion to pass a decision on termination of his/her membership in the Association was passed.



Article 7

A member of age has the right to:

1. participate in achievement of objectives of the Association equally with other members;
2. participate directly in decision making at the Assembly.
3. elect and be elected to Association bodies;
4. be informed on timely manner and completely about the activities of the Association.

A minor member of the organization has the rights referred to in Items 1 and 4 of hereabove. A minor member that has turned 14 years may attend the Assembly and participate in the discussion, but has no right to vote.

A member is obligated to:

1. contribute actively to achieving the objectives of Association;
2. participate in the activities of the Association in accordance with their personal interest and possibilities.
3. pay a membership fee;
4. encourage and suggest related development of goals, tasks, affairs and activities of the Association;
5. suggest different ideas, activities, projects and so on for the annual work program of the Association.
6. inform the Association, and through it other members about his activities related to the Association;
7. perform other duties assigned to him by the Association.

Article 8

Association bodies are the Assembly, Representative and President of the Association.

Article 9

Assembly is the supreme body of the Association.

Assembly consists of all members of the Association.

The Assembly meets regularly once a year. An extraordinary session can be set up by a reasoned proposal of the Representative, President as well as written initiative by at least one third of all members. An extraordinary session of the Association must be held not later than 30 days starting with the day of application for its convocation.

The President shall convene the Assemble session, by written notice on the time and place of holding the Assembly and the proposed agenda.

The Assembly:

1. makes the plan and program of work;
2. approves the Statute, as well as its amendments and supplements;
3. adopts other acts of Association;
4. considers and adopts narrative and financial plan and report;
5. decides about the membership fee for the next year;
6. decides about changes of the Statute and termination of Associations;
7. appoints two representatives and the President of Association;
8. decides about integration into unions.
